Course overview:

In Part 1, participants learn how to teach the equivalent of the Lotus Palm Thai Yoga Massage form currently taught in our 3-hour and 2-day Thai Yoga Massage courses. After taking Part 1, students have two years to complete Part 2, at which time they may receive their certificate.

In Part 2 participants expand on lessons learned in Part 1, equipping them with the necessary skills to teach the equivalent of the Lotus Palm Thai Yoga Massage form currently taught in our 5-day “Thai Yoga Massage I” intensive course.

The training will provide you with all the necessary components to be successful in your teaching and practice of Thai Yoga Massage. The course will be taught in English.

Duration:

The course takes place from June 3 to July 3, 2009. Part I runs from June 3 to June 17, 2008. Part II runs from June 18 to July 3, 2009. The daily schedule is from 9 am to 5 pm 5 days a week with a break for lunch.
